




Tone 1, Eothinon 1: Our Righteous Father Ephraim the Syrian; Venerable Palladios of Antioch; and Venerable Theodosios of Totma

First Antiphon:

- -It is good to give praise unto the Lord, and to chant unto Thy Name, O Most High.
- -To proclaim in the morning Thy mercy and Thy truth by night.

Refrain: Through the intercessions of the Theotokos, O Savior, save us.

-Upright is the Lord our God and there is no unrightenousness in Him.

Second Antiphon:

- -The Lord is King, He is clothed with majesty; the Lord is clothed with strength and has girt Himself.
- -For He established the world which not be shaken.

Refrain: Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, as we chant to Thee, Alleluia!

Come, let us worship and bow down before Christ!

Save us, O Son of God Who art risen from the dead, as we sing to Thee: Alleluia!

RESURRECTIONAL APOLYTIKION (Tone 1)

"While the stone was sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body, Thou didst arise on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. For which cause the heavenly powers cried aloud unto Thee, O giver of life. Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ, glory to Thy kingdom, glory to Thy providence, O Thou Who alone art the lover of mankind".

APOLYTIKION OF ST. EPHRIAM THE SYRIAN (Tone 3)

"Out of Paradise, a river floweth, * flooding all the earth with joy unending, * cheering souls with compunction and saving fear: * Ephraim, the wine bowl of gladness inspired of God, * from all eternity chosen to light the Church * with his sacred hymns, his sermons, his shining canticles, * whereby he filleth faithful souls with godliness".

TROPARION OF ST ANTHONY THE GREAT (Tone 4 Russian):

Like the zealous Elijah thou didst become, and followed John the Baptist in his upright ways. A dweller in the wilderness, thou didst steady the world by prayer. O Father Anthony, intercede with Christ our God for our souls' salvation.

KONTAKION OF THE PRESENTATION OF CHRIST (Tone 1)

Thou, O Christ God, Who by Thy Birth, didst sanctify the Virgin's womb, and, as is meet, didst bless Simeon's arms, and didst also come to save us; preserve Thy fold in wars, and confirm them whom Thou didst love, for Thou alone art the Lover of mankind.

Today's Epistle Reading:

Prokeimenon:

"Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us. Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous".

The Reading is from the First Epistle of St. Paul to Timothy (1:15-17)

"Timothy, my son, the saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. And I am the foremost of sinners; but I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display His perfect patience for an example to those who were to believe in Him for eternal life. To the King of Ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory to the ages of ages. Amen.

Today's Gospel Reading:

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Luke (18:35-43)

"At that time, as Jesus drew near to Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging; and hearing a multitude going by, he inquired what this meant. They told him, "Jesus of is passing by." And he cried, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" And those who were in front rebuked him, telling him to be silent; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" And Jesus stopped, and commanded him to be brought to Him; and when he came near, Jesus asked him, "What do you want me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, let me receive my sight." And Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well."

And immediately he received his sight and followed Him, glorifying God; and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God".
